Gloria sits on sofa.

EDITH

FADE OUT:

ACT TWO

INT. DAY - 704 HOUSER STREET

Forty-five minutes later.

ARCHIE

Serves you right, Meathead.

MICHAEL

What? What did I do? I didn't do anything.

EDITH

What's all the yelling about?

ARCHIE

Who, Edith, me? I'm not yelling.

Meathead here is just upset because

Barney Heffner's dog, Rusty, left a

welcome home present for him on the
porch.

Michael and Gloria sit down on the sofa. Archie sits in his favorite chair.

Really, Arch, how can you say that about the decision?

ARCHIE

Dummy up, you Meathead you. I told you I don't want to hear no more about that there.

MICHAEL

No, Arch, really! I want to know why you say that? Don't you think a woman has a right to decide what to do with her own body?

Archie stands up behind chair, Edith and Gloria exchange a silent "here we go again" look.

ARCHIE

That there is not the reason for that there new law, Meathead.

MICHAEL

ARCHIE

MICHAEL

Hello, Mrs. Lorenzo

IRENE

Hello, Micheal.

GLORIA

Hello, Mrs. Lorenzo.

IRENE

Hello, Gloria.

ARCHIE

Hey, Uh, Irene, there, why didn't you just fix the blender?

IRENE

For your information, Archie, the motor's burned out. I had to send away for a new one.

ARCHIE
